REGULATIONS

MADE UNDER

THE VOLUNTEER ORDINANCE,

(Chapter 88).

UNDER SECTION 31 OF THE VOLUNTEER ORDINANCE, THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS HAVE BEEN MADE BY THE GOVERNOR:

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Volunteer (Amendment) Regulations, 1963, and shall be construed and read with the Volunteer Regulations, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Regulations, and any Regulations amending the same.

2. The Principal Regulations are hereby amended as follows —

- (a) by the substitution for every reference to the expression "sub-regulation" or "sub-regulations" of a reference to the word "paragraph" or "paragraphs" respectively;
- (b) by the substitution for every reference to the word "paragraph" of a reference to the expression "sub-paragraph".

3. Paragraph (2) of regulation 3 of the Principal Regulations is hereby amended —

- (a) by the substitution of a full stop for the semicolon at the end of sub-paragraph (b); and
- (b) by the revocation of sub-paragraph (c).

4. Paragraph (1) of regulation 15 of the Principal Regulations is hereby revoked and the following paragraph substituted therefor —

"(1) Subject to the provisions of this regulation, every member of the Force, while in annual training under paragraph (a) of subsection (1) of section 17, shall receive rations or ration allowance in lieu thereof at the rate of 1.08 per day, and shall receive pay at the appropriate rate per day corresponding to his rank as follows —
