BRITISH GUIANA

REGULATIONS

MADE UNDER

THE SUGAR INDUSTRY SPECIAL FUNDS ORDINANCE,
(Chapter 248).

UNDER SECTION 9(2) OF THE SUGAR INDUSTRY SPECIAL FUNDS ORDINANCE, IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE 22 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF BRITISH GUIANA, AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS HAVE BEEN MADE BY THE GOVERNOR:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Sugar Industry (Labour Welfare Committee) (Amendment) Regulations, 1963, and shall be construed and read as one with the Sugar Industry (Labour Welfare Committee) Regulations* hereinafter referred to as the Principal Regulations.

2. Regulation 2 of the Principal Regulations is hereby amended by the insertion after the definition of the expression “the Committee” of the following definition —

‘ “the Minister” means the Minister for the time being charged with responsibility for Labour; ’.

3. Regulation 11 of the Principal Regulations is hereby revoked and the following regulation substituted therefor —

“Appoint-
ment of
Secretary of
the Committee,
and other
officers and
servants.

11. (1) The Committee may, with the approval of the Minister, appoint some fit and proper person to be Secretary of the Committee at such salary as may be approved by the Minister, and the Secretary shall not be dismissed without the approval of the Minister.

(2) The Committee may appoint and employ at such remuneration as it thinks fit such other officers and such servants as it deems necessary:

Provided that no salary in excess of the rate of four thousand, eight hundred dollars per annum shall be assigned to any post under this subsection without the prior approval of the Minister.”.

4. Paragraph (1) of regulation 8 of the Principal Regulations is hereby amended by the substitution of the word “Minister” for the words “Chief Secretary”.
