BRITISH GUIANA

REGULATIONS

MADE UNDER

THE SUMMARY JURISDICTION (MAGISTRATES) ORDINANCE,
(Chapter 12)

UNDER SECTION 63 OF THE SUMMARY JURISDICTION (MAGISTRATES) ORDINANCE, IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE 22 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF BRITISH GUIANA, AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS HAVE BEEN MADE BY THE GOVERNOR :—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Summary Jurisdiction (Magistrates') Money (Amendment) Regulations, 1963, and shall be construed and read with the Summary Jurisdiction (Magistrates') Money Regulations*, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Regulations, and any Regulations amending the same.

2. Regulation 7 of the Principal Regulations is hereby amended —

- (a) by the substitution of a colon for the full stop at the end of the regulation; and
- (b) by the insertion of the following proviso to the regulation —

“Provided that where the Minister responsible for finance so directs, receipts shall be made out by mechanical means in the form set out as Form 5A in the Appendix to the Summary Jurisdiction (Civil Procedure) Rules, 1939. The portion of the said form marked “A” shall be delivered to the payer and the portion marked “B” shall be attached to the case jacket or process in respect of which the fees and costs have been paid.”
