THE BRITISH GUIANA (SPECIAL SERVICE UNIT) ORDER, 1964.

UNDER SUB-PARAGRAPH (e) OF PARAGRAPH (2) OF ARTICLE 2 OF THE BRITISH GUIANA (SPECIAL SERVICE UNIT) ORDER, 1964, THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS HAVE BEEN MADE BY THE GOVERNOR:—

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Special Service Unit (Setting Aside or Acquisition of Property) Regulations, 1964.
- 2. The Governor may by order provide for the setting aside or acquisition of any land or other property for the use of the Special Service Unit and may in such order give such directions as appear to him to be necessary or expedient in connection therewith.
- 3. (1) Where any interest in or right over property of any description is acquired under the preceding regulation adequate compensation out of the funds of the Colony shall be promptly paid in respect thereof.
- (2) Any persons claiming any such compensation may apply to the Supreme Court for the determination of his interest in or right over the property and the amount of compensation.
- (3) Any party to the proceedings in the Supreme Court relating to any such claim shall have the same rights of appeal as he has for the purpose of and in relation to an action or matter in that Court.
