THE EMERGENCY POWERS ORDERS IN COUNCIL,
1939 — 1963

UNDER SECTION 6 OF THE EMERGENCY POWERS ORDERS IN
COUNCIL, 1939—1963, AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE
OF ALL POWERS ENABLING ME IN THAT BEHALF, I
HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS :—

Citation. 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Emergency Powers (Amendment) (No. 8) Regulations, 1964, and shall be construed and read with the Emergency Powers Regulations, 1964, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Regulations, and any Regulations amending the same.

Amendment of Regulation 18A. 2. Sub-paragraph (b) of paragraph (1) of regulation 18A of the Principal Regulations (as inserted by regulation 4 of the Emergency Powers (Amendment) (No. 4) Regulations, 1964) is hereby amended by the deletion of the full-stop appearing at the end thereof and the substitution therefor of the following —

“ or towards members of Her Majesty’s Forces in the Colony.”.
