REGULATIONS

Made Under

THE BRITISH NATIONALITY ORDINANCE,

(Chapter 100).

UNDER SECTION 2 (1) OF THE BRITISH NATIONALITY ORDINANCE AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL OTHER POWERS ENABLING ME IN THAT BEHALF, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS:—

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the British Nationality (Fees) Regulations, 1965.
- 2. A fee of seven dollars and twenty cents may be taken in British Guiana in respect of registration as a citizen of the United Kingdom and Colonies under section 1 of the British Nationality (No. 2) Act, 1964.
- 3. Any fee taken in pursuance of regulation 2 of these Regulations shall be paid to the Accountant General.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations, but is intended to indicate their general purport.)

These Regulations prescribe the fee to be paid by a person who has been stateless since birth making application for registration as a citizen of the United Kingdom and Colonies under section 1 of the British Nationality (No. 2) Act, 1964.
