BRITISH GUIANA

REGULATIONS

MADE UNDER

THE FIRE BRIGADE ORDINANCE, 1965

(No. 7 of 1957).

UNDER SECTION 31 OF THE FIRE BRIGADE ORDINANCE, 1957, IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE 22 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF BRITISH GUIANA, AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS HAVE BEEN MADE BY THE GOVERNOR'S DEPUTY.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Fire Brigade (Amendment) Regulations, 1965, and shall be read and construed with the Fire Brigade Regulations, 1957*, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Regulations, and any Regulations amending the same.

2. The fourth schedule to the Principal Regulations is hereby amended by the insertion of the following proviso at the end of paragraph 8 thereof —

“Provided that a member of the Brigade who has successfully completed an overseas training course approved by the Chief Fire Officer shall be exempted from the requirement to be examined for promotion.”
