BRITISH GUIANA

REGULATIONS

MADE UNDER

THE REGISTRATION OF BIRTHS AND DEATHS ORDINANCE

(Chapter 162)

UNDER SECTION 8 OF THE REGISTRATION OF BIRTHS AND DEATHS ORDINANCE, THE REGISTRAR GENERAL HAS MADE THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE GOVERNOR ACTING IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE 22 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF BRITISH GUIANA AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL OTHER POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF :—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Registration of Births and Deaths (Amendment) Regulations, 1965 and shall be construed and read as one with the Registration of Births and Deaths Regulations, 1917, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Regulations, and any Regulations amending the same.

2. Regulation 77 of the Principal Regulations is hereby amended by the substitution of the word "twenty-five" for the word "Twenty-four" in the eighth line thereof.

3. Regulation 90 of the Principal Regulations is hereby amended by the substitution of the word "twenty-five" for the word "twenty-four" in the seventh and ninth lines.

4. Regulation 116 of the Principal Regulations is hereby revoked and the following regulations substituted therefor :—

"116. (1) In addition to the actual reasonable travelling expenses incurred, the registrar shall be allowed a subsistence allowance at the rate of two dollars per day.

(2) For the purposes of this regulation, an absence —

- (a) of seven hours or more but not exceeding twelve hours, shall be reckoned as one-third of a day;
- but (b) exceeding twelve hours/not exceeding eighteen hours shall be reckoned as two-thirds of a day;
- (c) exceeding eighteen hours up to twenty-four hours shall be reckoned as a whole day".
