BRITISH GUIANA

REGULATIONS

MADE UNDER

THE BRITISH GUIANA (SPECIAL SERVICE UNIT) ORDER 1964.

UNDER SECTION 2 OF THE BRITISH GUIANA (SPECIAL SERVICE UNIT) ORDER 1964 AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL POWERS ENABLING ME IN THAT BEHALF I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS:

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Special Service Unit (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations 1965 and shall be construed and read with the Special Service Unit Regulations 1964, hereinafter referred to as the principal Regulations, and any Regulations amending the same. Citation.

2. Regulation 3 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended by the substitution for paragraph (1) of the following — Amendment of regulation 3 of principal Regulations.

“(1) The Unit shall perform within British Guiana any military duties required of it by or under the authority of the Governor and may be employed for the preservation of law and order, the preservation of the peace, the repression of internal disturbance, the protection of property, the apprehension of offenders, or the due enforcement of any laws with the enforcement of which it is charged for any of those purposes.”

3. Paragraph (2) of regulation 9 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended by the substitution of the words “may act ministerially for the purpose of the preservation of the peace” for the words “shall at all times act ministerially for the purpose of the preservation of the peace, the prevention of crime and the detection and committal of offenders”. Amendment of regulation 9 of principal Regulations.

4. Regulation 11 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended by — Amendment of regulation 11 of principal Regulations.

- (a) the deletion of the words, “in the event of war or other emergency,” in paragraph (1);
- (b) the insertion of the word “and” before the words “shall continue” in paragraph (1);
- (c) The substitution of the words “thenceforth unless” for the word “until” in paragraph (1);
- (d) the substitution of the words “whereupon they shall” for the words “and shall then” in paragraph (1);

- (e) the substitution of the words "any military force constituted under this regulation (including, without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing, the individual members of any such force)" for the words "members of the Unit to whom the proclamation applies" in paragraph (4);
- (f) the substitution of the words "Save as military service rules may otherwise provide, the" for the word "The" at the commencement of paragraph (5);
- (g) the deletion from paragraph (6) of all the words appearing after the words "service rules" in that paragraph.

5. Paragraph (1) of regulation 12 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended by the deletion of the words, "and that I will cause Her Majesty's peace to be kept and preserved by preventing to the utmost of my power all offences against the same".

6. Regulation 13 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended by —

- (a) the substitution of the words "or any part thereof, employed as mentioned in regulation 3 of these Regulations shall, to such extent as is in keeping with such employment," for the words "so long as he continues to be a member thereof, shall";
- (b) the substitution of the words "the like" for the words "all such" wherever they appear;
- (c) the deletion of the word "shall" where it appears for the second time.

7. Regulation 18 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended by the substitution of the words "arrest without a warrant the person in whose possession such property or article is found and to take custody thereof in order that it may, as soon as practicable, be taken before a" for the words "take such property or article and the person in whose possession the same is found before any".

8. Regulation 20 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended by the substitution for the proviso thereto of the following —

"Provided that he may, as soon as practicable after his arrest, be delivered or conveyed and delivered into the custody of a member of the Police Force to be dealt with in accordance with section 21 of the Police Ordinance, 1957, and otherwise according to law."

9. Regulation 22 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended by —

- (a) the substitution of the words "any warrant" for the words "any writ, warrant, order or summons";
- (b) the substitution of the words "the warrant" for the words "the writ, warrant, order, or summons" wherever they appear.

10. Regulations 23 and 25 of the principal Regulations are hereby revoked.

Revocation of regulations 23 and 25 of principal Regulations.

11. Paragraph (1) of regulation 26 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended by the substitution of the words "preservation of the peace or for the apprehension of offenders" for the words "prevention or detection of crime."

Amendment of regulation 26 of principal Regulations.

12. Paragraph (1) of regulation 39 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended by the substitution of the words "discharge any function lawfully assigned to him for the suppression of" for the word "suppress" in paragraph (c).

Amendment of regulations 39 of principal Regulations.

13. Paragraph (a) of regulation 40 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended by the deletion of the words "or process".

Amendment of regulation 40 of principal Regulations.

14. Paragraph (1) of regulation 67 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended by the deletion of sub-paragraph (1).

Amendment of regulation 67 of principal Regulations.
