REGULATIONS

MADE UNDER

THE FISHERIES ORDINANCE, 1956,

(No. 30 of 1956).

UNDER SECTION 33 OF THE FISHERIES ORDINANCE, 1956, THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS HAVE BEEN MADE BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL:—

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Fisheries (Amendment) Regulations, 1959, and shall be construed and read with the Fisheries Regulations, 1957*, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Regulations and any regulations amending the same.
- 2. (1) Paragraph 2 of regulation 10 of the Principal Regulations is hereby revoked, and the following substituted therefor
 - "(2) The sale of fish in the Fish Marketing Centre shall be subject to the approval of the superintendent and shall be by wholesale. The owner or captain of each fishing boat shall pay to the superintendent a landing fee in respect of all catches sold as aforesaid in accordance with the tariff set out in the third schedule".

- (2) Paragraph 3 of regulation 10 of the Principal Regulations is hereby revoked.
- 3. Regulation 14 of the Principal Regulations is hereby amended by inserting the words "over thirty-five feet in overall length" between the words "craft" and "moored" appearing therein.
- 4. The third schedule to the Principal Regulations is hereby revoked and the schedule to these Regulations substituted therefor.
