REGULATIONS

MADE UNDER

THE CUSTOMS ORDINANCE,

(Chapter 309).

UNDER SECTION 273 OF THE CUSTOMS ORDINANCE, THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS HAVE BEEN MADE BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL :—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Customs (Amendment No. 2) Regulations, 1959, and shall be construed and read as one with the Customs Regulations*, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Regulations, and any Regulations amending the same.

2. Appendix E to the Principal Regulations is hereby amended —

(a) by the deletion of the words “this schedule” appearing in lines five and seven of paragraph (c) of condition (ii), as inserted by the Customs (Amendment) Regulations, 1959‡, and the substitution therefor of the words “the First Schedule of the Customs Ordinance, Chapter 309”;

(b) (i) by the renumbering of condition (iii) as condition (v); and
(ii) by the insertion after condition (ii) of the following conditions :—

“(iii) Upon the exportation of drinking straws manufactured in the Colony, drawback in full of the duties paid on the importation of raw materials used in the manufacture of such articles.

(iv) Upon the exportation of ships and other craft built in the Colony, drawback in full of the duties paid on the importation of steel under Group 681 of Part I of the First Schedule of the Customs Ordinance, Chapter 309, used in the building of such ships and other craft.”
