## REGULATIONS

MADE UNDER

THE POST AND TELEGRAPH ORDINANCE,  
(Chapter 132).

UNDER SECTION 97 OF THE POST AND TELEGRAPH ORDINANCE THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS HAVE BEEN MADE BY THE POSTMASTER GENERAL WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Official Inland Correspondence (Amendment) Regulations, 1959, and shall be construed and read with the Official Inland Correspondence Regulations, 1955\*, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Regulations, and any Regulations amending the same.

2. The third schedule to the Principal Regulations is hereby amended as follows:—

- (a) by the insertion immediately after the word "Board" in the eighth line of the first column thereof of the words "and District Commissioners";
- (b) by the substitution for the words "The Chairman of local authorities and country districts of local administration" in the fourth, fifth and sixth lines of the second column thereof of the words "The Chairman of local authorities on matters of local administration";
- (c) by the addition thereto of the following in the first and second columns thereof —

"The Chairman, Vice-Chairman  
and Secretary of the Sea  
Defence Board  
to receive from

Members of the Sea  
Defence Board.

"The Director of Public Works  
to receive from  
District Engineers, Public  
Works Department  
to receive from

Surveyors.

Overseers, Public Works  
Department."
