TRADES UNIONS.

REGULATIONS

Regs. 45 of
1940.

*made by the Governor in Council under section 24 (h) on the 16th
October, 1940.*

FEES.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Trades Unions (Fees) Regulations.

2. (1) The fees specified in the schedule to these regulations shall be demanded and received by the Registrar in respect of the various matters specified in the said schedule.

(2) All fees shall be paid before the desired service is rendered.

1. For registering a trade union and giving a certificate of registration	5	00
2. For registering alterations in rules and giving a certificate of registration	1	00
3. For registering a change of name and giving a certificate of registration	1	00
4. For a direction to transfer stock	1	00
5. For registering a notice of dissolution	0	24
6. For registering an amalgamation of two or more trade unions and giving a certificate of registration	1	00
7. For each inspection of documents relative to one and the same trade union and filed with the Registrar	0	24
Provided that the Registrar may dispense with the payment of any fee for the inspection of documents where such fee would be payable by a public department.		
8. For each copy or extract of any document in the custody of the Registrar, whether certified or not by the Registrar, per folio of 72 words	0	08
Provided that the minimum fee receivable under this item shall be 24 cents.		
9. For each document required to be authenticated by the Registrar and not chargeable with any other fee	0	50
10. No fee shall be payable for, or in respect of—		
(a) the cancellation or withdrawal of a certificate of registration;		
(b) the filing with the Registrar of the return required by section 35 (1) of the Trades Unions Ordinance;		
(c) the filing of any notice of change of the situation of the registered office;		
(d) the filing of any notice of appointment of trustees or other officers; or		
(e) the supply of any document, or copy of any document, to a public department.
