REGULATIONS

made by the Governor in Council under section 24 (h) on the 16th October, 1940.

FEES.

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Trades Unions (Fees) Regulations.
- 2. (1) The fees specified in the schedule to these regulations shall be demanded and received by the Registrar in respect of the various matters specified in the said schedule.
 - (2) All fees shall be paid before the desired service is rendered.
