## IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON THE MINISTER BY SECTION 136 OF THE MINING ACT 1989, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING REGULATION:-

Citation and Commencement

Application

Application for Special Mining Permits

Grant of Special Mining Permit

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Mining (Special) Regulations 2006, and shall come into effect on the $8^{\text {th }}$ December 2005 and shall cease to have effect upon the expiration of licences granted under these Regulations.
2. These Regulations shall apply only for the purposes of and in relation to the application and grant for Special Mining Permits over the areas as described in Schedule 1 hereunder and to the extent only as set out in these Regulations.
3. (i) Application for Special Mining Permits for areas stated in Schedule 1, shall be made mutatis mutandis in accordance With the provision stated in Clause 43(3) of the Mining Act No. 20 of 1989.
(ii) Applications for Special Mining Permit over the areas set out in Schedule 1 shall be specific only to bauxite.
4. (i) In relation to the grant of Special Mining Permits for areas set out in Schedule 1, such Permits shall be of a maximum of three years duration and are renewable once only for a duration of one year.
(ii) The grant of Special Mining Permits for areas stated in Schedule 1 should cover no less than the following acreages:

| a) | 16 Bissaruni | - | 100 acres |

| c) | 22 Souwari | - | 60 acres |

## SCHEDULE 1.

## 20 Green Creek

## 22 Souwari

Tract $B$ being a point of state land known as Souwari and being a part of mining lease 581 situate on the right bank of Berbice River and commences at a galavanise pipe set in concrete based etched D.W.R, 1600 feet east of the intersection of three roads marked C, D and E and 987 feet south of center line of road E as shown on the said plan, and its boundaries extend thence $N 01^{\circ} 04^{\prime}$ $40^{\prime \prime}(T) 1153.82$ feet thence $N 72^{\circ} 30^{\prime} 52^{\prime \prime}(T) 1089.82$ feet. thence $N 96^{\circ} 41^{\prime} 26^{\prime \prime}$ (T) 118765 feet thence $N 187^{\circ} 03^{\prime} 04$ (T) 1399.62 feet thence $N 271^{\circ} 17^{\prime} 29^{\prime \prime}$ (T) 206940 feet to a point of commencement and containing an area of 68.506 acres.
