## THE CUSTOMS ACT

(Cap. 82:01)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTION 275 OF THE CUSTOMS ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS:—

1. These Regulations, which amend the Customs Regulations\*, may be cited as the Customs (Amendment) Regulations 1992.

2. Paragraph (b) of the proviso to regulation 77 of the Principal Regulations is hereby amended by the substitution for the words "one ounce" of the words "twenty-eight decimal four grams".

- 6. Form "C.2 of Schedule B to the Principal Regulations is hereby amended in the following respects

  - (b) in paragraph 6, by the substitution for the words "8 ounces" of the words "227 grams"; and
  - (c) in the latter portion, by the substitution for the words "Lb" and "Galls", wherever those words occur, of the words "Kgs" and "Ls". respectively.
