THE EXCISE REGULATIONS ACT

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTION 2 OF THE EXCISE REGULATIONS ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS:—

1. These Regulations, which amend the Beer Regulations*, may be cited as the Beer (Amendment) Regulations 1992.

- 2. Regulation 2 of the Principal Regulations is hereby amended, in the definition of the expression "beer", by the substitution for the words "two and a half percent of proof spirit", wherever those words occur, of the words "one decimal four percent alcohol".

- 3. Regulation 17 of the Principal Regulations is hereby amended as follows -

- (a) in paragraph (1) by the substitution for the words "thirty-six gallons" of the words "one hundred litres" and in the proviso thereto, by the substitution for the words "thirty-six" of the words "one hundred";
- (b) in paragraph 2(a), by the substitution for the words "eighty-four pounds" of the words "twenty-four kilograms"; and
- (c) in paragraph 2(b), by the substitution for the words "fifty-six pounds" of the words "sixteen kilograms"

Amendment of regulation 20 of the Principal Regulations,

4. Regulation 20 of the Principal Regulations is hereby amended in paragraph (1) (a), by the substitution for the words "sixty degrees Fahrenheit" of the words "fifteen decimal six degree Celsius".

Amendment of regulation 21 of the Principal Regulations. 5. Regulation 21 of the Principal Regulations is hereby amended in pragraph (1) (a), and (b), by the substitution for the words "sixty degrees Fahrenheit" of the words "fifteen decimal six degrees Celsius".

Amendment of regulation 29 of the Principal Regulations, 6. Regulation 29 of the Principal Regulations is hereby amended by the substitution for the words "thirty-six bulk gallons" of the words "one hundred litres" and for the words fifty-six pounds" of the words "sixteen kilograms".
