IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTION 16 OF THE PLANT PROTECTION ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS:—

1. These Regulations, which amend the Importation of Fruits and Vegetables Regulations*, may be cited as the Importation of Fruits and Vegetables (Amendment) Regulations 1993.

Citation.

2. Regulation 4(b) of the Principal Regulations is hereby repealed.

Amendment of regulation 4 of the Principal Regulations.

3. The Principal Regulations are hereby amended by the insertion after regulation 4 of the following regulations as regulations 5 and 6 —

Amendment of the Principal Regulations.

*Prohibition

5. The importation into Guyana of any fruit or vegetable from Surinam is hereby prohibited.

Cap. 68:03 Subsidiary Legislation.

Authorising

6. The Chief Agricultural Officer is hereby authorised to take steps for the immediate destruction, without compensation, of any diseased fruit or vegetable or any fruit or vegetable appearing to be infected with any animal or vegetable organism or other agent which is or is believed to be inimical to the growth of plants, which is imported from Surinam.”.
