IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTION 26 OF THE FACTORIES ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS:-

These Regulations, which amend the Factories (Health and Citation. 1. Welfare) Regulations*, may be cited as the Factories (Health and Welfare) (Amendment) Regulations 1984.

2. Regulation 2 of the Principal Regulations is hereby amended Amendment by the deletion of the word "male" from the definition of "young per-"Principal Regulations.

Regulation 16 of the Principal Regulations is hereby amended Amendment of regulation 16 of the Principal Regulations. 3. by the deletion of the words "and no female".

4. in the following respects -

- (a) (i) in paragraph (1) by the deletion of the words "or any female;
 - (ii) in paragraph (b) of the proviso to paragraph (1) by the deletion of the words "or female"; and
- (b) in paragraph (2) by the deletion of the word "and female".

Amendment of regulation 18 of the Principal Regulations is hereby amended to free by the deletion of the words "and females". Regulations.

Aumendment of Schedule to the Principal Regulations. (a) 6. The Schedule to the Principal Regulations is hereby amended

- (a) by the deletion of the words "women and";
- (b) by the deletion of column 2;
- (c) by renumbering columns (3) to (8) (inclusive) as (2) to (7) respectively; and
- (d) by the substitution in column (6) as renumbered for the words "Columns (5) and (6)" of the words "Columns (4) and (5)".
