THE FORESTS ACT (Cap. 67:01)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTION 42 OF THE FORESTS ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING **REGULATIONS :—**

1. These Regulations, which amend the Forests Regula-^{Citation.} tions*, may be cited as the Forests (Amendment) Regulations 1985.

2. Regulation 7 (3) of the Principal Regulations is hereby Amendment amended by the substitution for the words "not exceeding \$500" & of the of the words "not less than \$1,000".

3. Regulation 7 A(3) of the Principal Regulations is here-Amendment by amended by the substitution for the words "not exceeding 7A of the \$500" of the words "not less than \$25,000".

4. Regulation 8 of the Principal Regulations is hereby Amendment amended by the insertion after paragraph (4), of the following a of the Principal paragraph as paragraph (5) -Principal Regulations.

> "(5) Every lessee or permittee of a wood-cutting tract or any other person who desires to have permission for any of the transport privileges under this regulation shall make application therefor to the Commission and shall pay in respect thereof the prescribed fee."

Seventh Schedule. (2) Every such licence shall be in the form set out in the Seventh Schedule and shall continue in force until the 31st December of the year in which it is issued.

(3) No person shall carry on the business of purchasing charcoal or firewood for resale unless he is the holder of a licence issued under this regulation.".
