 - (b) by the insertion after the word "coffin" where it occur for the econd time of the word "or bier"; and
 - (c) by the ubititution for the full top at the end thereof of a colon and by the insertion of the following proviso at the end thereof

"Provided that the Chairman of the Board may, for reasons of public health, when granting approval for the remation of the human remain of any per on, direct that the corp e shall be tran ported to the crematorium only in a clo ed coffin and where any such direction is given the corpse shall be tran ported to the crematorium only in a closed coffin.".
