REGULATIONS

THE POST AND TELEGRAPH ACT

(Cap. 47:01)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTION 97 OF THE POST AND TELEGRAPH ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS:—

- 1. These Regulations which amend the Telegraph Regu-Citation and lations*, may be cited as the Telegraph (Amendment) Regulations ment.

- 2. The Principal Regulations are hereby amended by the Amendment of the substitution of the Schedule hereto for the Schedule thereto. Principal Regulations.

SCHEDULE

1. Porterage

The charge for porterage referred to in regulation 3 shall be 35 cents for 1.6 kilometres or one mile or part thereof beyond 1.6 kilometres or one mile radius from the telegraph office.

2. Registration Fees

- (a) The charge for registration of ... \$15.00 per annum a telegraphic address
- (b) The charge payable for every change of address occurring during the year of registration. \$7.50

3. Inland Telegrams

Telegrams transmitted between any two telegraph offices in Guyana and delivery of same within 1.6 kilometres or one mile of the telegraph office of destination:

Provided that in the case of interior telegraph offices at which the nature of the terrain makes delivery impracticable, no such delivery shall be made —

(a) Ordinary telegrams —

First 10 words or portion thereof	\$2.50
Each additional word	.25
Urgent telegrams — First 10 words or portion thereof Each additional word	\$ 5.00 .50
