# (Cap. 95:02)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTION 26 OF THE FACTORIES ACT. I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING **REGULATIONS:-**

These Regulations, which amend the Factories (Health and Citation. Welfare) Regulations\*, may be cited as the Factories (Health and Welfare) (Amendment) Regulations 1983.
