**IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON THE MINISTER  
BY SECTION 25 OF THE ROADS ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE  
FOLLOWING REGULATIONS:—**

Citation. 1. These Regulations, which amend the Demerara Harbour Bridge Regulations 1978\*, may be cited as the Demerara Harbour Bridge (Amendment) Regulations 1981.

Amendment of Schedule to the Principal Regulations. 2. The Principal Regulations are hereby amended by the substitution for the Schedule thereto, of the Schedule hereto.

## Tolls for Demerara Harbour Bridge

(iii) exceeding 4,400 lbs. but not exceeding 6,600 lbs.	30.00
<b>Motor Lorry with —</b>	
(i) 2 axles	48.00
(ii) 3 axles or more	60.00
<b>Motor Bus (including a Mini Bus)</b>	<b>24.00</b>
<b>Motor Tractor with up to two axles</b>	<b>18.00</b>
<b>Trailer with —</b>	
(i) 1 axle	18.00
(ii) 2 axles	30.00
<b>Motor cycle</b>	<b>1.20</b>
<b>Pedal cycle</b>	<b>.30</b>

A goods vehicle exceeding 6,600 lbs. (unladen) will be classified as a Motor Lorry and will be required to pay the toll charges appropriate to the number of axles.
