REGULATIONS

Made Under
THE DEFENCE ACT

(Cap. 15:01)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON THE DEFENCE BOARD BY SECTION 212 OF THE DEFENCE ACT, THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS ARE HEREBY MADE BY THAT BOARD:—

1. These Regulations, which amend the Defence (Pensions and Gratuities) Regulations* may be cited as the Defence (Pensions and Gratuities) (Amendment) Regulations 1981. Citation.

2. Regulation 12 of the Principal Regulations is hereby amended in the following respects — Amendment
of regulation
12 of the
Principal
Regulations.

(i) by substituting, in paragraph (2), a colon for the full stop at the end and inserting thereafter the following proviso —

“Provided that no such approval shall be required when the President is the competent appointing authority in relation to any officer.”;

(ii) by inserting, after paragraph (2), the following paragraphs as paragraphs (3) and (4) —

(3) In paragraph (2) “competent appointing authority”, means —

- (a) in relation to an officer, the Minister;
- (b) in relation to a soldier, the Chief of Staff or any other officer of the Force duly authorised by the Chief of Staff.

(4) Without prejudice to the provisions of paragraph (2), the approval required under that paragraph for permitting an officer or soldier to continue as a member of the force may be given also by —

- (a) the President in the case of an officer or soldier; and
- (b) the Head of the Presidential Secretariat in the case of a soldier.’

Amendment of regulation 16 of the Principal Regulations. 3. Regulation 16 of the Principal Regulations is hereby amended by substituting the words “Defence Board” for the word “Board”.

Amendment of regulation 22 of the Principal Regulations. 4. Regulation 22 of the Principal Regulations is hereby amended by renumbering it as paragraph (1) of that regulation and by inserting, after paragraph (1) as so renumbered, the following paragraph as paragraph (2) —

“(2) Without prejudice to the provisions of paragraph (1), the functions conferred on the Defence Board by regulations 15 to 221 (inclusive) may be exercised also by the Head of the Presidential Secretariat.”.
