THE GUYANA CITIZENSHIP ACT  
(Cap. 14:01)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTION 16 OF THE GUYANA CITIZENSHIP ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS:—

**1.** These Regulations, which amend the Guyana Citizenship Regulations, may be cited as the Guyana Citizenship (Amendment) Regulations 1981.

**2.** Regulation 3 of the Principal Regulations is hereby amended as follows

- (a) by the substitution in the marginal note, for the words "by a woman", of the words "under Article 42(1) of 45";
- (b) by the substitution, for the word "woman", of the word "person"; and
- (c) by the deletion of the words "who is a British protected person or an alien".

**3.** FORM R. 1 of the FIRST SCHEDULE to the Principal Regulations is hereby amended as follows:—

- (a) by the substitution, for the words "WOMAN" and "HER" in the heading, of the words "PERSON" and "HIS OR HER" respectively;
- (b) by the substitution, for the words "husband" and "husband's", wherever those words occur, of the words "(husband/wife)", and "(husband's/wife's)" respectively.
- (c) by the substitution —
  - (i) for the word "his" in paragraph 7. of the words "his or her";

- (ii) for the word "her", wherever it occurs, of the words "his or her"; and
- (iii) for the word "she" in paragraph 10, of the words "he or she";
- (d) by substitution, in the sentence within the brackets immediately before the asterisked note, for the words "If the applicant is a British Protected person or an alien the", of the word "The";
- (e) by the substitution, in the OATH OF ALLEGIANCE, for the words "of Guyana" of the words "of the Co-operative Republic of Guyana"; and
- (f) by the insertion of the following note in the margin to paragraphs 4 and 9 :—  
"Delete word in ( ) which does not apply".
