(No. 1 of 1985)

- IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTIONS 52 and 90 OF THE RICE (REGULATION OF MANUFACTURING AND MARKETING) ACT 1985, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS:—
- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Rice (Regulation Citation of Manufacturing and Marketing) (Licence for Export) Regulations 1986.7
- 2. Every application for the grant of a licence to carry application on the business of export of padi or rice or any other product for ilcence. of padi shall be made to the General Manager of the Board in Form A set out in the Schedule.
- 3. (1) A licence granted by the Board to carry on the Grant of business of export of padi or rice or any other product of padi schedule shall be in Form B set out in the Schedule.
- (2) The licence shall be granted to the applicant on the payment by him of a licence fee of one hundred dollars.
- (3) The licence shall be subject to the conditions specified therein and to such other conditions as may be prescribed by the Minister by regulations or specified, from time to time, by the Board.
