THE SHIPPING CASUALTIES (INVESTIGATION AND PREVENTION)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED BY SECTION 25 OF THE SHIPPING CASUALTIES (INVESTIGATION AND PREVENTION) ACT. THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS ARE HEREBY MADE:—

- 1. These Regulations, which amend the Coasting and Pass-Citation. enger Trade Regulations*, may be cited as the Coasting and Passenger Trade (Amendment) Regulations 1982.
