RESOLUTION NO. ~~CMLXVI~~ CLVI

WHEREAS the duly authorised representatives of the Government of Guyana on 12th May, 1979, signed a Letter of Intent for a Stand-By Agreement with the International Monetary Fund, hereinafter referred to as the Fund, under which the Government of Guyana requested, over a period of three years, commencing 26th June, 1979, the right to purchase from the Fund up to the equivalent of SDR 62.75 million i.e. approximately 206.42 million Guyana dollars;

AND WHEREAS the Board of the Fund approved of the request on 25th June, 1979, and the request was accordingly countersigned by the Fund, thereby constituting a Stand-By Agreement with the Fund;

RESOLVED, That this National Assembly approve of the action taken by the Government of Guyana in relation to the Stand-By Agreement with the Fund signed on 12th May, 1979.
