whereas the conditions governing the payment of superannuation benefits to non-pensionable employees of the Government as authorised by Legislative Council Resolutions No. LII of 6th July, 1951, and No. LVI of 8th May, 1957, provide interalia that an employee who at the date of his retirement holds an "approved appointment" and has served in an approved appointment for at least twenty continuous years immediately preceding the date of his retirement will be eligible for an annual allowmance;

AND WHEREAS provision has been made in the Pensions Act (Chapter 27:02) with effect from 1st July, 1975 conferring authority on the Minister assigned responsibility for the public service, in the special circumstances of any particular case, to approve the grant of an annual allowance on retirement to a person who has held a non-pensionable office for a period shorter than twenty years;

AND WHEREAS the Government considers it desirable that similar authority should be conferred on the Minister in relation to employees of the Government whose emoluments are paid out of an open vote:

RESOLVED, That this Assembly approves that the conditions authorised by the aforementioned Resolutions of the Legislative Council be varied with effect from 1st July, 1975 to authorise the Minister assigned responsibility for the public service, in the special circumstances of any particular case, to approve of the grant of an annual allowance on retirement to an employee of the Government whose empluments are paid out of an open vote and who has served in the public service for a shorter period than twenty years.
