FIRST LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL.

SECOND SESSION.

RESOLUTION No. LXIV.

THAT, with reference to Governor's Message No. 13 of 1930, this Council approves of the recommendations contained in the Report of the Select Committee of this Council dated 2nd July, 1930, regarding assistance by way of a grant from Imperial Funds to enable this Government to undertake the works mentioned in the Schedule hereunder, for the relief of unemployment, and for a loan of £100,000 for the purpose of establishing an Agricultural Loan Bank.
