RESOLUTION No. YH.

Whereas a Petition has been presented to the Legislative Council by over 17,000 inhabitants of the Colony of British Guiana praying that the Cinematograph Ordinance, 1912, Amendment Ordinance, 1916, be amended to permit all Cinematograph entertainments on Sundays;

And Whereas before the Petition goes through the usual channels, it is felt that the opinion of the members of this Council should be expressed on this matter:

Be it Resolved,—That this Council recommend that the Cinematograph Ordinance, 1912, Amendment Ordinance, 1916, be amended to permit Cinematograph entertainments being held on Sundays after 8.30 p.m.;

And be it further Resolved,—That the Government be asked to introduce a bill during the present session of the Council to give effect to this Resolution.
