RESOLUTION No. XXXI.

WHEREAS the policy of the Government in pledging this Colony to expenditure before consultation with the Legislature is unconstitutional and inimical to the best interests and good government of the country :

Be it Resolved,—That the united protest of the Electives of this Council be recorded in the minutes of this Council against any such pledges of expenditure, whether such payments be made upon the advice of the Executive Council, or not.
