RESOLUTION No. XXXII.

WHEREAS unemployment in this Colony is assuming menacing proportions owing to the prevailing economic stagnation ;

AND WHEREAS there have been indications of oil production in this Colony in commercial quantity ;

AND WHEREAS the conservation of the oil resources of the Empire is duly appreciated :

Be it Resolved,—That this Council respectfully request the Colonial Office to cause investigation to be made of the oil resources of this Colony with a view to a proportionate allowance consistent with any plans of Empire conservation being granted to it.
