RESOLUTION No. XXX.

Whereas under the existing Pension Legislation certain senior officers of Government transferred to this Colony from the services of other Colonies are penalized in the computation of their pensions on eventually retiring from the service as compared with officers who have served under the British Guiana Pension Regulations for considerable period:

Be it Resolved,—That this Council requests His Excellency the Officer Administering the Government to direct the framing of a Bill in revision of the existing Pensions Ordinances with a view of removing the disability suffered by the aforesaid officers.
