RESOLUTION No. LII.

That this Council adopts the majority report of the Committee appointed by His Excellency the Officer Administering the Government to consider and determine the route and terminus of the road from Bartica to the Interior with the following modifications:—

- (a.) That the offer of £12,100 be accepted on the understanding that Government will apply for the additional sum required to extend the road to the junction of the east and west Caburi Rivers.
- (b.) That Government will ask that the loan be free of interest for five years irrespective of whether a development loan be raised within that period or not.
- (c.) That in the event of the additional sum required under (a) not being granted Government will re-consider the recommendation to invite this Council to vote such additional sum,
