LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL.

FIRST SESSION, 1928.

RESOLUTION No. XXI.

That, with reference to the Governor's Message No. 21 of 1928, this Council approves of the sums required by the Colony from time to time for the execution of works and for other services, the cost of which will be defrayed from loans to be raised, being advanced by the Crown Agents for the Colonies by the issue of Treasury Bills or at Bank rate varying as the circumstances may require, until such time as the necessary Loans have been raised.

Further, that this Council approves of any sums advanced by the Crown Agents for the purposes of financing the general commitments of the Colony being similarly advanced by the issue of Treasury Bills or at Bank rate varying as the circumstances may require, until such time as there are surplus funds from the Colony in the hands of the Crown Agents available for the purpose.

Passed by the Legislative Council this 9th day of January, 1929.
