SECOND LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL.

FIRST SESSION.

RESOLUTION No. X.

That, with reference to Governor's Message No. 8 of 1930, this Council approves of and authorises the issue by the Crown Agents for the Colonies of British Guiana Treasury Bills for the purpose of obtaining the sums required by the Colony from time to time for the execution of works and for other services the cost of which will be defrayed from loans to be raised by the Colony or from grants to be made to the Colony out of the Imperial Exchequer until such time as the necessary Loans have been raised or the Imperial grants have been received as the case may be.

Further this Council approves of and fixes present limits for such Treasury Bill issues of £250,000 in respect of loans to be raised by the Colony and of £125,500 in respect of authorised grants from the Imperial Exchequer.

Legislative Council Resolution No. XXI. of 1928 is hereby cancelled.
