SECOND LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL.

FIRST SESSION, 1930.

RESOLUTION No. XXXIV.

THAT, with reference to Governor's Message No. 29 of the 15th of September, 1931, this Council approves of the two representatives being sent from this Colony, one to be selected by the Governor and one by the British Guiana Sugar Producers' Association and the Georgetown Chamber of Commerce jointly, to attend a Conference likely to be convened at Ottawa in October, 1931, between representatives of the parties to the Canada-West Indies Trade Agreement of 1925, for the purpose of considering ways and means of improving trade relations between Canada and the British West Indies.

Passed by the Legislative Council this 22nd day of September, 1931.
