

**NINTH PARLIAMENT OF GUYANA

RESOLUTION NO. 164

WHEREAS Standing Order 9 provides that “unless there are special reasons for so doing, no sitting of the National Assembly shall be held between the 10th August and 10th October in any year”;

AND WHEREAS Standing Order 111 provides that any one or more of the Standing Orders may be suspended, after notice, or with the leave of the Speaker, on a motion by a member at any sitting;

AND WHEREAS the 9th Parliament held its first sitting on September 28, 2006 and shall, by the effluxion of time in accordance with the Article 70 (3) of the Constitution, stand dissolved on the 27th day of September 2011;

AND WHEREAS the suspension of this Standing Order will allow the government to conclude its legislative agenda for the 9th Parliament;

RESOLVED,

That the National Assembly agrees to suspend Standing Order 9 in order to allow the Parliament to continue to sit no later than or until September 27, 2011
