RESOLUTION NO. 43

WHEREAS the United Nations Convention on the Law of the Sea was opened for signature in Kingston, Jamaica, on 10th December, 1982;

AND WHEREAS the aforesaid Convention has been hailed as the most significant legal instrument to be negotiated by the international community, in so far as it prescribes a comprehensive regime for all uses of the maritime spaces beyond national jurisdictions;

AND WHEREAS participation in the aforesaid Convention has particular importance and relevance for the conduct of Guyana's foreign policy, both bilaterally and multilaterally;

AND WHEREAS the aforesaid Convention requires the Deposit of sixty Instruments of Ratification or Accession for its entry into force;

AND WHEREAS by the deposit by Guyana of the sixtieth Instrument of Ratification on 16 November, 1993, the aforesaid Convention shall enter into force on November 16, 1994;

RESOLVED, That the National Assembly endorses the decision of the Executive to Ratify the United Nations Convention on the Law of the sea.

Passed by the National Assembly on 10th November, 1994.
