**RESOLUTION NO. 65**

WHEREAS the Constitution (Amendment) Bill 1995 - Bill No. 15 of 1995 - was not passed by the National Assembly on 10th August, 1995;

AND WHEREAS it is imperative in the national interest that the Constitution be amended as set out in the aforesaid Bill to facilitate the timely preparation of electoral laws for the next general election;


AND WHEREAS it is the consensus of Members of the Assembly that the Constitution should be so amended;

AND WHEREAS a new Constitution (Amendment) Bill 1995 - Bill No. 18 of 1995 - with the amendments proposed, has been prepared:

RESOLVED,

That Standing Orders Nos. 60 and 46 be suspended to enable the new Constitution (Amendment) Bill 1995 - Bill No. 18 of 1995 - to be considered by the National Assembly through all its stages at the sitting of the Assembly on Friday, 24th November, 1995.
