RESOLUTION NO. 66

WHEREAS the United Nations was established at the end of the Second World War in 1945 to, *inter alia*, "save succeeding generations from the scourge of war" and "to promote social progress and better standards of life in larger freedom";

AND WHEREAS its Charter which defined the purposes, principles, functions and structure of the Organisation offers member states a comprehensive framework for international co-operation;

AND WHEREAS, notwithstanding its imperfections, the United Nations continues to enjoy the confidence of the international community as evidenced by its almost universal membership;

AND WHEREAS Guyana having been admitted into membership on 20 September 1966 is proud to be a member in good standing of the United Nations for the past twenty-nine years:


RESOLVED,
