RESOLUTION NO. 7

WHEREAS the Constitution of Guyana requires that estimates of the revenues and expenditure of Guyana for any financial year should be laid before the National Assembly;

AND WHEREAS the Constitution also provides that when the estimates of expenditure have been approved by the Assembly an Appropriation Bill shall be introduced in the Assembly providing for the issue from the Consolidated Fund of the sums necessary to neet that expenditure;

AND WHEREAS estimates of revenues and expenditure of Guyana for the financial year 1990 have been prepared and laid before the Assembly on 1990--03-28;

RESOLVED, That this National Assembly approves the estimates of expenditure for the financial year 1990, of a total sum of sixty eight hundred and forty eight million, six hundred and seventy two thousand dollars (6,848,672,000), net of appropriation-in-aid and excluding thirty four hundred and fifty two million, six hundred and fifty one thousand dollars (\$3,452,651,000) which is chargeable by law, as detailed therein and summarized in the undermentioned schedule, and agree that it is expedient to amend the law and to make further provision in respect of finance. <u>SCHEDULE</u>
