EXTENSION OF THE LIFE OF
PARLIAMENT FROM 3RD APRIL TO
2ND JUNE, 1991.

WHEREAS the life of the Parliament which first met on 3rd February, 1986, consequent on the election of members thereof in the election held on 9th December, 1985, was by the alteration of article 70 of the Constitution by the Constitution (Amendment) Act 1991 extended by two months;

AND WHEREAS the said extension which began on 3rd April, 1991, will come to an end on 2nd April, 1991, on the expiration of which period Parliament shall stand dissolved unless there is in accordance with the Constitution (Amendment) Act 1991, a further extension of the life of Parliament;

AND WHEREAS the preparation of the official list of electors by house to house enumeration cannot be completed by 2nd April, 1991;

AND WHEREAS further time is needed for the preparation of the official list of electors;

AND WHEREAS by the Constitution (Amendment) Act 1991, the life of Parliament may further be extended for two months or less at a time by resolution supported by two-thirds of the elected members of the National Assembly and assented to by the President, so however that the life of Parliament shall not be extended beyond 30th September, 1991:

RESOLVED, That this National Assembly in accordance with the Constitution (Amendment) Act 1991, approves of the extension of the life of Parliament for a further period of two months, from 3rd April, to 2nd June, 1991.

Passed by the National Assembly on 25th March, 1991, in accordance with paragraph 3 of article 70 of the Constitution.
