## RESOLUTION NO. 13

WHEREAS the Standing Orders used by the National Assembly were made several years ago;

AND WHEREAS constitutional and other changes have from time to time taken place since these Standing Orders were made;

AND WHEREAS a New Constitution providing for the restructureing of the society and the economy of Guyana on socialist principles was prepared by the People of Guyana and was adopted in 1980 for the Co-operative Republic of Guyana;

AND WHEREAS it is expedient that the Standing Orders of the National Assembly be modified and revised to bring them into conformity with the new Constitution and with other changes and requirements:

RESOLVED, That the National Assembly refer the Standing Orders to the Standing Orders Committee for review and revision and for report thereafter to the Assembly.

Passed by the National Assembly this 22nd day of June, 1981
