RESOLUTION NO. 38

WHEREAS despite world-wide condemnation of the hostile acts of the U.S. against the Sandinista Government of Nicaragua, such as the mining last year of Nicaraguan waters and its continued support of the "contras" operating in that country, the U.S. has now mounted an economic embargo against Nicaragua;

AND WHEREAS the Non-Aligned countries and the CARICOM Foreign Ministers continue their support and commitment to the Contadora process, after expressing deep concern over the imposition by the U.S. of the embargo since it seems likely to jeopardise that process:

RESOLVED, That this National Assembly -

- (a) condemns the U.S. economic embargo and the continuing hostility to the Nicaraguan Government by Washington,
- (b) calls on the Government of Guyana to give all-round support to the Nicaraguan Government and people, and
- (c) brings to the attention of the Security Council the escalating threat to peace in the region.
