AN ORDINANCE to amend the Dangerous Drugs Ordinance.

[13th April, 1957]

Enacted by the Legislative of British Guiana:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Dangerous Drugs (Amendment) Ordinance, 1957, and shall be construed and read as one with the Dangerous Drugs Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance, and any Ordinance amending the same.

2. Paragraph (e) of subsection (1) of section 10 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the substitution for the words "not less than one-fifth per cent of morphine or one-tenth per cent of cocaine or of ecgonine" appearing therein of the words "any proportion of morphine or cocaine or cogonine."
