AN ORDINANCE to amend the Exchange Control Ordinance, 1958.

[7th August, 1965]

Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana:—

A.D. 1965.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Exchange Control (Amendment) Ordinance, 1965, and shall be construed and read as one with the Exchange Control Ordinance, 1958, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance, and any Ordinance amending the same.

Repeal of certain provisions of the Exchange Control (Amendment) Ordinance, 1962.

2. In this Ordinance —

“the Ordinance of 1962” means the Exchange Control (Amendment) Ordinance, 1962.

3.(1) The provisions of the Ordinance of 1962, other than paragraph (b) of section 2 and paragraph (a) of section 3, are hereby repealed.

(2) As from the commencement of this Ordinance the provisions of the Principal Ordinance as amended or repealed by the provisions of the Ordinance of 1962 repealed by subsection (1) of this section, shall have effect as if the repealed provisions of the Ordinance of 1962 had not been enacted.
