ORDINANCE NO. 12 OF 1933.

AN ORDINANCE to extend the operation of the Rice (Export Trade) Ordinance, 1932, to the thirty-first day of August, 1933.

A.D. 1933.

WHEREAS the Rice (Export Trade) Ordinance, 1932, is limited to continue in force until and including the thirtieth day of June, nineteen hundred and thirty-three ;

And whereas it is expedient that the operation of the said Ordinance should be continued till the thirty-first day of August, nineteen hundred and thirty-three :

Be it, therefore, enacted by the Governor of British Guiana, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows :—

Short Title. 1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Rice (Export Trade) Ordinance, 1933, and shall be construed with the Rice (Export Trade) Ordinance, 1932, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.
